

II**AMENDMENT****OFFERED BY MR. WEINER OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle B of title II, add the following:

1 **SEC. 215. ENERGY STAR STANDARDS.**

2 (a) ENERGY STAR.—Section 324A(c) of the Energy
3 Policy and Conservation Act is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (6)(B), by striking “and”
5 after the semicolon at the end;

6 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period at
7 the end and inserting a semicolon; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(8) in establishing and revising Energy Star
10 product category, specification, or criterion, re-
11 quire—

12 “(A) submission of the model number for
13 each product tested for compliance; and

14 ~~“(B) inclusion of developmental products~~
15 planned for sale within 2 years in the testing of
16 products submitted for purposes of such estab-
17 lishment or revision;

18 “(9) establish a scaled grading system for prod-
19 ucts identified as Energy Star products pursuant to
20 this section, with the most energy efficient of those

1 products receiving an 'A' and the least energy effi-
2 cient of those products receiving an 'F';

3 "(10)(A) review the 10 product categories that
4 use the greatest amount of energy at least once
5 every 3 years; and

6 "(B) based on the review, update and publish
7 the Energy Star product criteria for each such cat-
8 egory, as necessary; and

9 "(11) require periodic verification of compliance
10 with the Energy Star criteria by products identified
11 as Energy Star products pursuant to this section,
12 including—

13 "(A) purchase and testing of products
14 from the market; or

15 "(B) other appropriate testing and compli-
16 ance approaches."

17 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
18 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out the amend-
19 ments made by this section \$5,000,000 for fiscal year
20 2010 and each fiscal year thereafter.
