Add at the end of part 3 of subtitle B of title I of
division B the following:

1 **SEC. 1150. TIMELY ACCESS TO POST-MASTECTOMY ITEMS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(h)(1) of the Social
3 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m) is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subparagraph (H) as sub-
5 paragraph (I); and

6 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
7 lowing new subparagraph:

8 “(H) SPECIAL PAYMENT RULE FOR POST-
9 MASTECTOMY EXTERNAL BREAST PROSTHESIS
10 GARMENTS.—Payment for post-mastectomy ex-
11 ternal breast prosthesis garments shall be made
12 regardless of whether such items are supplied to
13 the beneficiary prior to or after the mastectomy
14 procedure or other breast cancer surgical proce-
15 dure. The Secretary shall develop policies to en-
16 sure appropriate beneficiary access and utiliza-
17 tion safeguards for such items supplied to a

1 beneficiary prior to the mastectomy or other
2 breast cancer surgical procedure.”

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This amendment shall be-
4 come effective upon enactment.

Add at the end of section 1305 the following:

1 (d) REPORT TO CONGRESS ON BARRIERS TO PRE-
2 VENTIVE SERVICES.—Not later than 12 months after the
3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health
4 and Human Services shall report to Congress on Medicare
5 beneficiary barriers, such as physician referral require-
6 ments or being a part of the Welcome to Medicare Phys-
7 ical Exam, to abdominal aortic aneurysm screening and
8 other preventative services as approved by the U.S. Pre-
9 ventive Services Task Force. Furthermore, using existing
10 educational resources, the Secretary shall make educating
11 patients and physicians regarding the risk factors for an
12 abdominal aortic aneurysm and when beneficiaries should
13 be screened, a priority.
