H.R. 1084, the “Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act” (CALM), was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

H.R. 1258, the “Truth in Caller ID Act of 2009”, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

An amendment in the nature of a substitute (manager’s amendment) by **Mr. Boucher, # 1**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.

H.R. 3633, a bill to allow the funding for the interoperable emergency communications grant program established under the Digital Television Transition and Public Safety Act of 2005 to remain available until expended through fiscal year 2012, and for other purposes, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee by a voice vote.
