

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. SHADEGG & MR. WHITFIELD

H.R. 2868

Strike section 2111 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3, and make such technical and conforming changes as may be necessary.

In section 2101(2) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3, strike subparagraph (S) and redesignate subparagraphs (T) and (U) as subparagraphs (S) and (T), respectively.

In section 2101 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3, strike paragraph (12).

In section 2103(f)(2) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3—

- (1) in subparagraph (I), insert “and” after the semicolon;
- (2) strike subparagraph (J); and
- (3) redesignate subparagraph (K) as subparagraph (J).

In section 2117(a)(2) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3, strike subparagraph (F) and redesignate subparagraphs (G), (H), (I), and (J) as subparagraphs (F), (G), (H), and (I), respectively.

In section 2118 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as proposed to be added by section 3—

(1) in paragraph (1), strike “, of which \$100,000,000 shall be made available to provide funding for methods to reduce the consequences of a terrorist attack”;

(2) in paragraph (2), strike “, of which \$75,000,000 shall be made available to provide funding for methods to reduce the consequences of a terrorist attack”; and

(3) in paragraph (3), strike “, of which \$50,000,000 shall be made available to provide funding for methods to reduce the consequences of a terrorist attack”.

In section 3(f), strike paragraph (2) and redesignate paragraphs (3), (4), and (5) as paragraphs (2), (3), and (4), respectively.
