

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3258
OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE OF NEW JERSEY

At end of subsection (k) of section 1433 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, as amended by section 2 of the bill, add the following:

1 “(3) CONFIDENTIAL COMMUNICATION OF IN-
2 FORMATION; AIDING INSPECTIONS.—The Adminis-
3 trator, or a duly designated representative of the
4 Administrator, shall offer non-supervisory employees
5 of a covered water system the opportunity confiden-
6 tially to communicate information relevant to the
7 employer’s compliance or noncompliance with this
8 section, including compliance or noncompliance with
9 any regulation or requirement adopted by the Ad-
10 ministrator in furtherance of the purposes of this
11 section. Where there is a recognized bargaining
12 agent described in subsection (f)(3)(B), an employee
13 representative shall be given an opportunity to ac-
14 company the Administrator, or the duly designated
15 representative of the Administrator, during the
16 physical inspection of any covered water system for
17 the purpose of aiding such inspection,

covered water system will also be accompanying the Administrator or the duly designated representative of the Administrator on such inspection.
