

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 515

OFFERED BY MR. WHITFIELD OF KENTUCKY

Page 1, line 10, strike “b. or c.” and insert “b., c., or d.”.

Page 1, line 20, and page 2, lines 9 and 18, redesignate subsections b. through d. as subsections c. through e., respectively.

Page 1, after line 19, insert the following new subsection:

- 1 “b. Subsection a. shall not apply if—
- 2 “(1) in the view of the Commission there is
- 3 adequate short-term and long-term disposal capacity
- 4 in the United States with respect to the class of
- 5 waste to be disposed, taking into account waste of
- 6 that class that is anticipated from domestic and im-
- 7 ported sources for disposal; and
- 8 “(2) the applicant for such a license holds a
- 9 valid export license for—
- 10 “(A) any of the imported waste that was
- 11 not permitted to be imported under the terms
- 12 of the import license; and

1 “(B) any of the low-level waste to be im-
2 ported for which disposal capacity in the United
3 States is not available.”.

Page 2, after line 22, insert the following new sub-
section:

4 “f. The holder of a license permitted under this sec-
5 tion shall, prior to importation, certify to the Commission
6 that the material being imported pursuant to the license
7 is the low-level radioactive waste to which the license ap-
8 plies. The Commission shall conduct random inspections
9 of such importation to ensure that the material being im-
10 ported is the waste to which the license applies. In addi-
11 tion to any other penalty provided for under this Act, the
12 Commission may revoke such a license if it finds that the
13 material being imported is not the waste to which the li-
14 cense applies.”.
