COMMITTEE ACTION

Committee on Energy and Commerce

Wednesday, March 10, 2010

The Committee on Energy and Commerce met in open markup session and took the following actions:

**H.R. 3125, the Radio Spectrum Inventory Act**, as amended by the Subcommittee on Communications, Technology, and the Internet on January 21, 2010, was **ordered favorably reported**, amended, to the House by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute (manager's amendment) by **Mr. Waxman (on behalf of himself, and Messrs. Boucher, Barton, and Stearns), # 1**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.

**H.R. 3019, the Spectrum Relocation Improvement Act of 2009**, was ordered favorably reported to the House by a voice vote.

There were no amendments offered to H.R. 3019.

**H.R. 1258, the Truth in Caller ID Act of 2010**, as amended by the Subcommittee on Communications, Technology, and the Internet on October 8, 2009, was **ordered favorably reported**, amended, to the House by a voice vote.

Chairman Waxman asked **unanimous consent** that the language changing the title of the bill will be considered part of the bill's text. **No Objection.**

The following amendment was offered:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute (manager's amendment) by **Mr. Boucher, # 1**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.
