**H.R. 3655, Bereaved Consumer's Bill of Rights Act of 2009**, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendments were offered:

An amendment to the Rush manager's amendment by **Mr. Barton, # 1A**, was **defeated** by a voice vote.

**H.R. 3993, Calling Card Consumer Protection Act**, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

A manager's amendment by **Mr. Rush, # 1**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.
