COMMITTEE ACTION

Committee on Energy and Commerce

Wednesday, May 5, 2010

The Committee on Energy and Commerce met in open markup session and took the following actions:

H.R. 3993, Calling Card Consumer Protection Act, as amended by the Subcommittee on Commerce, Trade, and Consumer Protection, was **ordered favorably reported** to the House, amended, by a voice vote.

The following amendment was offered:

A manager's amendment by **Mr. Waxman, # 1**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.

H.R. 3655, Bereaved Consumer's Bill of Rights Act of 2009, was considered and subsequently withdrawn from consideration, vacating the actions taken below.

The following amendments were offered:

An amendment by **Mr. Barton, # 1**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 13 - 31.

An amendment by **Mr. Gingrey, # 2**, was considered.

A substitute amendment by **Ms. Harman, # 2a**, to the Gringrey amendment # 2, was considered.

Note: During Committee consideration of H.R. 3655, Chairman Waxman stated that (without objection) he was withdrawing the bill from consideration of the Committee. Subsequently, full Committee consideration of H.R. 3655, and all actions taken thereto, would be vacated.
