H.R. 847, the “James Zadroga 9/11 Health and Compensation Act of 2010”, was ordered favorably reported to the House, amended, by a roll call vote: 33 – 12.

An amendment by **Mr. Gingrey, # 1g**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 15 – 31.

An amendment by **Mr. Shimkus, # 1h**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 17 – 26.

An amendment by **Mr. Shadegg, # 1i**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 13 – 29.

An amendment by **Mr. Burgess, #1j**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.

An amendment by **Mr. Burgess, # 1k**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 16 – 29.

An amendment by **Mr. Gingrey, # 1l**, was **defeated** by a voice vote.

An amendment by **Mr. Burgess, # 1m**, was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 12 – 30.

Mr. Hill moved that the Committee reconsider the vote held earlier on **the Burgess amendment, # 1k**. The motion to reconsider the vote was agreed to by a voice vote.

The vote was again taken on the amendment by **Mr. Burgess, # 1k**, which was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 21 – 22.

An amendment by **Mr. Burgess, # 1n**, was **defeated** by a voice vote.

An amendment by **Mr. Burgess, # 1o**, was **adopted** by a voice vote.

An amendment by **Mr. Gingrey, # 1p** was **defeated** by a roll call vote: 14 – 30.
