

AMENDMENT TO THE COMMITTEE PRINT
OFFERED BY MR. SARBANES

At the end of title I, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 109. DRIVER ALCOHOL DETECTION SYSTEM RE-**
2 **SEARCH.**

3 (a) RESEARCH.—The Secretary shall carry out a col-
4 laborative research effort to continue to explore the feasi-
5 bility and the potential benefits of, and the public policy
6 challenges associated with, more widespread deployment
7 of in-vehicle technology to prevent alcohol-impaired driv-
8 ing.

9 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
10 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
11 a report annually to the Committee on Energy and Com-
12 merce of the House of Representatives and the Committee
13 on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Sen-
14 ate—

15 (1) describing progress in carrying out the col-
16 laborative research effort; and

17 (2) including an accounting for the use of Fed-
18 eral funds obligated or expended in carrying out that
19 effort.

1 (c) AUTHORIZATION.—From amounts appropriated
2 under section 30104 of title 49, United States Code, the
3 Secretary is authorized to expend \$8,000,000 during each
4 of fiscal years 2011 through 2015 to conduct the research
5 required under this section.
