Dear Madam Commissioner:

The Committee on Energy and Commerce and its Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations are examining the safety of the nation's food supply, including the recent outbreak of *Salmonella* associated with eggs from Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa.

To assist the Committee in its investigation, we request that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) produce the following documents for the time period from January 1, 2007, to the present:

1. All documents relating to FDA inspections of the facilities of Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa that are currently ongoing, including reports, supporting records, and microbiological tests;
2. All unredacted Forms 483 relating to any FDA inspections of the facilities of Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa;
3. Copies of all contracts, agreements, or memoranda of understanding between FDA and any Iowa state agency that is responsible for conducting inspections on FDA's behalf, including the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship and the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals;
4. All reports, memoranda, or correspondence relating to any inspections of the facilities of Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa conducted by any Iowa state agency, including the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship and the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals;

5. All reports, memoranda, or correspondence relating to microbiological testing conducted internally or by an independent testing laboratory of food materials or products used or produced by Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa;
6. All consumer reports or complaints relating to Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa or any related facilities;
7. All correspondence, including e-mails between employees of FDA and employees of Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa; and
8. All correspondence, including e-mails, between employees of FDA and the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship, the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals, or any independent microbiological testing firm regarding possible violations of food safety protocols or regulations at any facilities of Wright County Egg and Hillandale Farms of Iowa.

Please produce the requested information by Tuesday, September 7, 2010. An attachment to this letter provides additional information about responding to Committee document requests.
