7 (c) DEFINITION.—Section 799B of the Public Health
8 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 295p) is amended by adding at
9 the end the following:

10 “(27) VETERINARY PUBLIC HEALTH.—The
11 term ‘veterinary public health’ includes veterinarians
12 engaged in one or more of the following areas to the
13 extent such areas have an impact on human health:
14 biodefense and emergency preparedness, emerging
15 and reemerging infectious diseases, environmental
16 health, ecosystem health, pre- and post-harvest food
17 protection, regulatory medicine, diagnostic labora-
18 tory medicine, veterinary pathology, biomedical re-
19 search, treatment of food animals in underserved
20 areas, and government practice.”.
