Dear Messrs. Jensen:

Pursuant to Rules X and XI of the U.S. House of Representatives, the Committee is examining the facts surrounding the recent outbreak of *Listeria monocytogenes* that originated in cantaloupe traced back to Jensen Farms in Granada, Colorado.

On September 14, 2011, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announced that Jensen Farms issued a voluntary recall of its cantaloupes. To date, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimate that 123 people have been infected with the disease in 26 states and that 25 people have died, making this the deadliest foodborne illness outbreak in the last 25 years. This week, FDA released preliminary information that provides an overview of the factors that potentially contributed to the contamination of the cantaloupes. FDA also issued a warning letter to your company citing that 13 of the 39 environmental samples collected from Jensen Farms packaging facility tested positive for *Listeria*.

The Committee has a long bipartisan history of conducting food safety oversight and is very concerned about these recent developments. We intend to learn more from the FDA, CDC, Jensen Farms, and others who may provide insight into the causes of this outbreak and the prevention of future outbreaks.






