

**AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE PRINT OF TITLE I
OFFERED BY MS. SCHAKOWSKY OF ILLINOIS**

Page 1, after line 11, insert the following:

1 (c) EXCEPTION TO PROTECT CONSUMERS FROM EX-
2 CESSIVE OR UNJUSTIFIED PREMIUM INCREASES.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall
4 not apply with respect to any award under section
5 1311(a) of the Patient Protection and Affordable
6 Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(a)) for a State to carry
7 out the corrective actions described in paragraph (6)
8 of such section.

9 (2) FUNDING FOR CORRECTIVE ACTIONS FOR
10 EXCESSIVE OR UNJUSTIFIED PREMIUM INCREASES
11 THROUGH PLANNING AND ESTABLISHMENT
12 GRANTS.—Section 1311(a) of the Patient Protection
13 and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(a)) is
14 amended—

15 (A) in paragraph (3), by inserting “, and
16 to carry out the corrective actions described in
17 paragraph (6)” before the period at the end;
18 and

19 (B) by adding at the end the following new
20 paragraph:

1 “(6) CORRECTIVE ACTIONS FOR EXCESSIVE OR
2 UNJUSTIFIED PREMIUM INCREASES.—The Secretary
3 or the relevant State insurance commissioner or
4 State regulator shall take corrective actions to en-
5 sure that any excessive or unjustified increases in
6 premiums for health insurance coverage, as identi-
7 fied pursuant to section 2794 of the Public Health
8 Service Act, are corrected prior to implementation,
9 or as soon as possible thereafter, including through
10 mechanisms such as—

11 “(A) denying rates;

12 “(B) modifying rates; or

13 “(C) requiring rebates to consumers.”.
