

An Amendment to the Amendment  
Offered by Mr. Griffith of Virginia, *as amended by Mr. Rush*

In section 3(b)(1), insert after subparagraph (D) the following (and redesignate accordingly):

(E) any resulting positive or negative changes in the incidences of asthma and asthma attacks and other pulmonary disease;

(F) any resulting positive or negative changes in the occurrence of birth and developmental defects;

(G) any resulting positive or negative changes in the occurrence of premature mortality;

(H) any resulting positive or negative changes in the occurrence of other adverse health effects;

(I) the positive and negative effects on clean energy jobs;

(J) the positive and negative effects on clean energy companies, including companies that export clean energy technology;

(K) the positive and negative effects on regional air quality, including any resulting change in the impairment of visibility, due to reduced pollution;

(L) the positive and negative effects on the water quality of lakes and streams;

(M) any resulting positive or negative changes in the number of work days missed;

(N) any resulting positive or negative changes in the number of school days missed;

(O) any resulting positive or negative changes in the use of emergency medical services;

(P) the impact of increased<sup>or decreased</sup> air pollution in the air of the Northern Hemisphere by virtue of jobs leaving<sup>or coming</sup> the United States of America to countries in the Northern Hemisphere that do not have substantially similar laws and regulations of the United States of America.

In section 3(b)(4), insert after subparagraph (D) the following (and redesignate accordingly):

(E) vulnerable subpopulations, including the poor, working poor, elderly, pregnant women, and populations with pulmonary disease;
