

Ms. Eshoo's amendment preserves the Federal Communications Commission Collaboration Act that was incorporated into H.R. 3309 and incorporates several recommendations adopted in June by the Administrative Conference of the United States (ACUS) calling on the agencies to develop "best practices" designed to increase opportunities for public participation and to enhance the quality of information received by the agencies.
