

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 910**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MATHESON OF UTAH**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 4. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

2 It is the sense of the Congress that—

3 (1) there is established scientific concern over  
4 warming of the climate system based upon evidence  
5 from observations of increases in global average air  
6 and ocean temperatures, widespread melting of snow  
7 and ice, and rising global average sea level;

8 (2) addressing climate change is an inter-  
9 national issue, involving complex scientific and eco-  
10 nomic considerations;

11 (3) the United States has a role to play in re-  
12 solving global climate change matters on an inter-  
13 national basis; and

14 (4) the Congress should develop a policy that  
15 addresses this role.
