**OFFERED BY MR. RUSH OF ILLINOIS**

In section 2(b)(3), insert “and the Deputy Secretary of Labor” before the period.

In section 2(b)(4), insert “and the Deputy Secretary of Energy” before the period.

At the end of section 2(b), add the following:

1           (12) The Chair of the Council on Environ-  
2           mental Quality.

3           (13) The Secretary of the Interior.

4           (14) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-  
5           ices.

6           (15) The Director of the Centers for Disease  
7           Control and Prevention.

8           (16) The Director of the National Institute of  
9           Environmental Health Sciences.

Amend section 2(c) to read as follows:

10          (c) CHAIR.—The Secretary of Commerce and the  
11          Chair of the Council on Environmental Quality shall serve  
12          as co-chairs of the Committee. In carrying out the func-

1 tions of the Chair, the co-chairs shall consult with the  
2 members of the Committee.

In section 2(d), insert “stakeholders and relevant ex-  
perts, including” after “reports issued by,”.

In section 3(b)(1), insert after subparagraph (D) the  
following (and redesignate accordingly):

3 (E) any resulting reduction<sup>or increase</sup> in the  
4 incidences of asthma and asthma attacks and  
5 other pulmonary disease;

6 (F) any resulting reduction<sup>or increase</sup> in the occur-  
7 rence of birth and developmental defects;

8 (G) any resulting reduction<sup>or increase</sup> in the occur-  
9 rence of premature mortality;

10 (H) any resulting reduction<sup>or increase</sup> in the occur-  
11 rence of other adverse health effects;

12 (I) the effect on promoting clean energy  
13 jobs;

14 (J) the effect on promoting clean energy  
15 companies, including companies that export  
16 clean energy technology;

17 (K) the improvements in regional air qual-  
18 ity, including reductions in the impairment of  
19 visibility, due to reduced pollution;

1 (L) the improvements in water quality of  
2 lakes and streams;

3 (M) any resulting reduction in the number  
4 of work days missed;

5 (N) any resulting reduction in the number  
6 of school days missed;

7 (O) any resulting savings due to decreased  
8 use of emergency medical services;

In section 3(b)(4), insert after subparagraph (D) the following (and redesignate accordingly):

9 (E) vulnerable subpopulations, including  
10 the elderly, pregnant women, and populations  
11 with pulmonary disease;

12 (F) the environment, including impacts on  
13 global climate change;

14 (G) development of infants and children;
